## Smoke visible across Angle Park

Saturday 15 May, 2010

The Metropolitan Fire Service (MFS) advises people in and around Angle Park, Wingfield and Regency Park that a large amount of smoke is visible in the area.

The smoke is due to a fire in a factory in Angle Park that started just before midnight last night. The fire is expected to burn for much of the day and smoke may continue to be observed across part of the city into the evening.

MFS Incident Controller Glenn Benham says the smoke is currently moving in a west-south-westerly direction.

“Those travelling in the area should exercise caution as smoke may reduce visibility.”

“Residents in the area who are concerned about the presence of smoke, are advised to close doors and windows until the smoke passes,” he said.

People with respiratory problems are advised to stay inside and close all doors and windows until the smoke has passed.

While the MFS is aware of smoke in the Angle Park area, it does advise residents that should they observe a fire burning unattended, that they should call Triple Zero immediately.
