## Smoke advice for Angle Park area

Sunday 16 May, 2010

The Metropolitan Fire Service (MFS) advises people in and around Angle Park and Wingfield area that a large amount of smoke is travelling in a north-north-east direction from the site of a factory fire in the area.

The smoke is due to a fire that started in a refrigeration factory just before midnight Friday night. More than 1400 tonnes of frozen and chilled food has been destroyed, along with the factory, and continues to smoulder.

Firefighters have so far been unable to gain internal access to the factory to fully extinguish the hot spots, due to structural instability of the walls. Engineers are on-site to work closely with MFS in this area.

The MFS advises members of the public who may be concerned at the presence of smoke in the area, that they should close doors and windows and stay inside where possible.

People travelling in the area should exercise caution as smoke may reduce visibility.

While the MFS is aware of smoke in the Angle Park area, it does advise residents that should they observe a different fire burning unattended, that they should call Triple Zero immediately.
